

EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS HEAVY RAIN/FLOODS

OUTSIDE

- Never attempt to walk across a flooded area or drive through flood waters. The water could sweep you and your vehicle away and it may be deeper than you think.
- If your car stalls in rising water, abandon it and head to a higher, dryer place of safety.
- Report any damaged sewer, water, or electrical lines.



INSIDE

- Place wet floor pylon in front entranceways if mats are wet.
- Place signs on doors stating, "Caution: floors may be wet due to severe weather conditions."
- Place additional mats at the front entrance to control excess water.
- Close entranceways where rain may be blown into the workplace.
- Monitor automatic doors to ensure that they function properly.
- Inspect every 30 minutes at entranceways and first fifty feet inside workplace.
- Check electrical system(s) for any sparks or obvious damage.
- Check sewage and water line(s) for leaks.
- Check for any gas leaks or fires that may have started.
- Check sub-pumps are working.
- Monitor low lying areas for flooding, such as basements, load dock ramps, etc.
