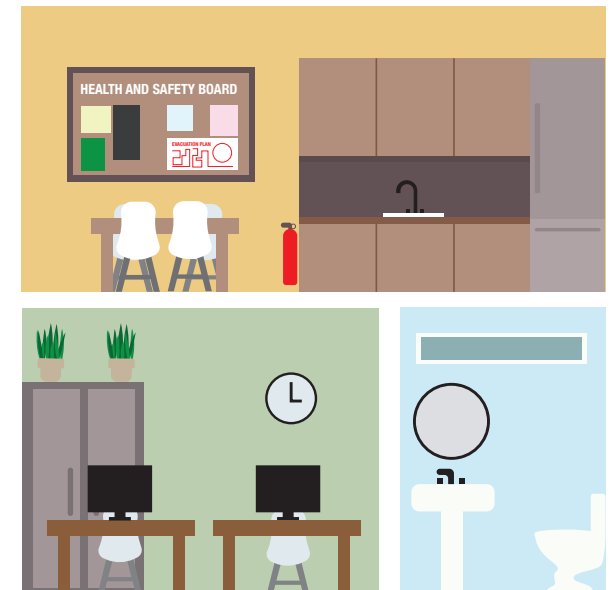


EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS TORNADO

Watch for tornado danger signs: dark, often greenish clouds (caused by hail, wall clouds, and debris).

INDOOR:
In a high-rise building, pick a hallway in the centre of the building. Do not assume you will have time to get to the lowest floor, so ensure there is a safe place identified on all floors of the building.

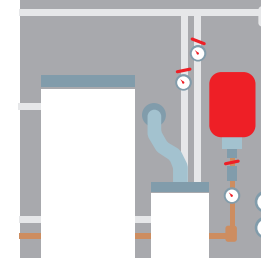


OUTDOORS:

- If possible, seek safety in a basement, shelter, or sturdy building.
- If strong winds and flying debris occurs while driving, pull over and park, keep your seat belt on and engine running. Put your head down below the windows and cover your head with your hands and a blanket, if available.
- Contact your employer when safe to do so, provide an update on your safety and any property or equipment damage.

WHAT'S THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN A WATCH AND A WARNING?

- A tornado watch means a tornado is possible.
- A tornado warning means a tornado is already occurring or will occur soon. If you hear or see a tornado warning, get to your safe place immediately!



INDOOR:

Identify a safe place in your business where staff will gather during a tornado, such as a basement, storm cellar, or an interior room on the lowest floor with no windows.
